

Biographies for our Queens' Federation Governors

Sarah Attle has been a governor for the last 11 years and has had 3 children at Queen Edith School. Sarah has a background in law and mediation, is Link Governor for Year 5 at Queen Edith's and sits on the Management and Communications Committee; Sarah is particularly interested in the impact of pupil premium funding, pupil well-being and ensuring each child reaches their potential.

Nathalie Boyd has a background in Humanities and Education. She is a Co-opted Governor and sits on the School Improvement Committee. Nathalie is particularly interested in the teaching of literacy (especially writing), languages and music.
