

Constitution and Structure 2025/26

Queens' Federation Governing Body

In order to meet the skill requirements necessary to fulfil our core functions, we can have a total of 15 Governors on our Governing Body, (except at any time when the headteacher has given notice under Regulation 19 of the Constitution Regulations that s(he) chooses not to be a governor, when the total number of governors will be 14) broken down as follows:

- 2 elected Parent Governors (elected by the parent body of schools in the Federation).
- 1 Local Authority Governor.
- 1 Headteacher (Executive Headteacher of the Federation).
- 1 elected Staff Governor (elected by staff of the Federation).
- 7 Co-opted Governors (of which up to 3 may be members of staff). The total number of co-opted governors who are also eligible to be elected as staff governors, when counted with the elected Staff Governor and Headteacher, must not exceed one third of the total membership of the Governing Body.
- 3 Partnership Governors (appointed by the Federation on nomination from parents of registered pupils or such other persons in the community).

The Term of office for all Governors (other than the Headteacher) is four years.
